



WORKING AT: **CADIA VALLEY OPERATIONS (CVO)**



Location

Cadia Valley Operations (CVO) is located in central western New South Wales. It is approximately 25 kilometres south-west of the city of Orange and 250 kilometres west of Sydney. Orange is a regional town of nearly 40,000 people. It has a wide range of amenities, a prominent health sector, excellent educational facilities, shopping, transport and other services such as child care centres.

Climate

Orange has a temperate climate with consistent rainfall throughout the year - about 900mm annually. The average daytime temperature in summer is 24 degrees Celsius and 10 degrees Celsius in winter but temperatures can fall below zero. Orange's high elevation of 862m makes it cooler than many surrounding areas with the odd snowfall possible.

Accommodation and facilities

CVO has no on-site accommodation. A wide range of accommodation is available in Orange and the surrounding region.

On-site Crib Rooms provide kitchen facilities such as fridges, dishwashers, toasters, vending machines, pie warmers and sandwich toasters. Food orders can be delivered to the site. There are change houses located across site which include showers, lockers, washing machines and dryers.

Employees on duty have access to the on-site medical centre for urgent and non-urgent medical treatment. CVO offers a range of health and wellbeing initiatives which have been developed in conjunction with locally based providers that are aimed at improving the quality of life of our employees.

Recreation

Orange has a comprehensive range of sporting and recreation facilities such as golf clubs, swimming pools and gyms, cultural centres, parks, botanic gardens, walking trails, wineries, restaurants, bars, cafes, galleries and a cinema.

Orange is well known for its food and wine. A monthly farmers market and seasonal festivals are held throughout the year such as the Orange F.O.O.D Week, Wine Week, Frost Fest, and Slow Summer.
