- Engage with internal and external stakeholders, including local communities and governments, to support effective risk assessment processes aimed at identifying, monitoring and managing security-related risks;
- Investigate and effectively respond to security-related incidents, including any allegations of human rights abuses;
- Review our security performance in order to continuously improve our security management approach; and
- Identify and assess strategies for continuous improvement of our security performance.

All security personnel (both employees and contractors) are required to comply with this Policy and our *Human Rights Policy*.
